## From the Pastor's Laptop

Today's Gospel (Mt.18:15-20) is perfect for our Parish Festival Weekend. Jesus says: "Where two or three are gathered together in my name, there am I in the midst of them." At our Festival we will have several hundred gathered joyfully in the name of the Lord for fun and fellowship.

In today's Gospel, Jesus also talks about the joy we feel when we bring sinners back to the Church: "Go and tell him his fault between you and him alone. If he listens to you, you have won over your brother." Jesus explains that we should warn sinners privately at first so that they are not embarrassed in front of others, and then later on "if he does not listen, take one or two others along with you." This Gospel passage shows how important it is to warn sinners. But it also shows us that we should not be warning sinners all the time and everywhere. There is a time and a place. For example, the Parish Festival would not be a good time and place for fraternal correction.

When it comes to bringing up people's faults, I usually ask the Holy Spirit and Our Lady to inspire me know just what to say and when. In public we should be like Jesus who did not hesitate to "eat and *drink with sinners.* "(cf. Mt. 11:19) Certainly He was joyful and friendly with them and did not publicly reprimand them. This is what Pope Francis means when he says that we should rub elbows with sinners on the streets, that we should be close to the poor and the unwashed, that the shepherds should smell like the sheep.

How wonderful it is that Our Lord tells us that there is an appropriate time for everything and that we should just be joyful and

accepting of others. At our Parish Festival we welcome everyone, Catholics and non-Catholics alike, anyone who wishes to come and join in the fun. It is a time to show hospitality and love since we are all brothers and sisters gathered in the name of the Lord. See you at the Parish Festival!

## 🔊 Religious Education—23rd Sunday in Ordinary Time, 2014–Fr. Mark

### "You shall love your neighbor as yourself."

Saint John Paul II said that the human person is a good towards which the only proper and appropriate response is love (*Love and Responsibility p. 41*). But of course people disagree on what is meant by love. Love is very different from lust. Lust is a using of another for the sake of pleasure without the openness to creating a family life together. True marital love is open to life, while lust is fruitless and barren and only leads to more selfishness and spiritual death. We should warn people when we see that their actions lead them away from life. Today's first reading warns us: "If you do not speak out to dissuade the wicked from his way, the wicked shall die for his guilt, but I will hold you responsible for his death." True love does not stay silent about things that are harmful

That is why the Church must teach that same-sex marriage is harmful and should not be allowed by law. It is not appropriate for raising children; and also, the couple themselves cannot find true integral happiness in such a relationship. I see this clearly when working with Courage, which is a Catholic ministry for those who suffer from the difficulty of same-sex attraction. Courage groups are anonymous support groups for those who wish to support each other in living a pure life according to Catholic teachings (Couragerc.org). Some Courage members know from experience that the gay lifestyle does not lead to happiness. All of them believe the Church's warnings. Courage members experience love, acceptance and support. They learn that they are children of God deserving of love, even if they didn't always experience unconditional love in childhood. They heal from negative past experiences which may have caused their inordinate hunger for love. They learn to peacefully accept their circumstances, that may have caused their inability to have normal attraction toward the opposite sex.

On July 21, President Obama gave a new executive order which will discriminate against the Catholic Church. The order bans federal employees and contractors from discriminating against "homosexual" or "transgendered" employees. The U.S. Bishops say that this order is "unprecedented and extreme" because it does not include an exemption for churches. If in the future the Church wants to contract with the government for federal funds, it would have to be silent about Church teaching. Beginning in 2015 the Catholic Church could be penalized for saying that same-sex marriage is wrong. We would be denied access to federal funds because of our moral teachings. But we cannot be silent. We cannot stop telling the truth. The fact is that these are unhealthy and disintegrating and destructive behaviors. Same -sex marriages do not bring true happiness and fulfillment. Nor are they good for conceiving and raising children. Cross-dressing is not good therapy for those who have feelings that they belong to the opposite sex. People who experience same-sex attraction carry a difficult cross. There is no easy solution for them to feel better. We can only treat them with love and respect, give them good advice, urge them to live chaste lives, and support them with wholesome friendships with people who understand their situation. It is unfortunate that now if we say these things, the law of our land will accuse us of discrimination and proceed to discriminate against us.

Here at St. Joseph's we are God's family and we welcome all God's children. At the same time we want what is best for them. May we always be guided and inspired by St. Joseph, who is the patron saint of families, of husbands, and of all people who choose to live a chaste life.

## Youth Ministry



#### The tree of the Cross

The Church Fathers, the Pope said, "always compared the tree of Paradise with the tree of sin; the tree that bears the fruit of the knowledge of good and evil, with the tree of the Cross". The tree of Paradise "did such great harm", whereas the tree of the Cross "brings us salvation and health, and pardons that harm". It is this "itinerary that human history follows". It is a way that enables us "to encounter Jesus Christ the Redeemer, who lays down his life for love". The tree of the Cross tells the story of God who "wanted to take on our history and to walk beside us". In the First Reading the Apostle Paul "sums up the whole of God's story in few words: Jesus Christ, though he was in the form of God, did not consider it a privilege to be like God". Rather, the Pope explained, he "emptied himself, taking the form of a servant, being born in the likeness of men". Indeed Christ "humbled himself and became obedient unto death, even death on a Cross." This is "the itinerary that God's story followed". But, the Bishop of Rome wondered, why did it do so? The answer is found in Jesus' words to Nicodemus: "for God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life". God, Pope Francis concluded, "took this itinerary out of love, there is no other explanation".

"Amarás al prójimo como a ti mismo."

San Juan Pablo II dijo que la persona humana es un bien hacia cual la única respuesta adecuada y apropiada es el amor (Amor y Responsabilidad, p. 41). Más sin embargo, muchos no están de acuerdo de lo que significa el amor. El amor es muy distinto al deseo sexual o lujuria. La lujuria es un uso del otro para el placer sin estar abierto a crear una vida familiar juntos. El amor matrimonial verdadero está abierto a la vida, mientras la lujuria no tiene frutos y es estéril y sólo lleva a más egoísmo y la muerte espiritual. Debemos de advertir a la gente cuando veamos que sus acciones los va a llevar de la vida. La primera lectura de hoy nos advierte: "si tú no hablas para advertir al malvado que abandone su mala conducta, el malvado morirá por su culpa, pero a ti te pediré cuenta de su sangre." El amor verdadero no se queda callado de las cosas dañinas. Es por eso que la Iglesia debe enseñar que el matrimonio del mismo sexo es dañino y no debe estar permitido por ley. No es apropiado para criar a niños; y también la pareja no puede encontrar la felicidad verdadera integral en dicha relación. Veo esto claramente cuando trabajo con el grupo "Courage", lo cual es un ministerio católico para aquellos que sufren de la dificultad de atracciones del mismo sexo. Los grupos de "Courage" son grupos de apoyo anónimos para aquellos que quiere apoyarse en vivir una vida pura según las enseñanzas católica (Couragerc.org). Algunos miembros de "Courage" saben de experiencia que el estilo de vida gay no lleva hacia lafelicidad. Todos creen las advertencias de la Iglesia. Los miembros de "Courage" experimentan el amor, aprobación, y apoyo. Aprenden que son hijos de Dios merecedores de amor, aún cuando no siempre experimentaban el amor incondicional como niños. Se sanan de experiencias negativas pasadas cuales pueden haber causado su hambre desproporcionado para el amor. Aprenden a aceptar pacíficamente sus circunstancias los cuales pueden haber causado su inhabilidad de tener atracción normal hacia el sexo opuesto. El 21 de julio, el Presidente Obama dio una orden ejecutiva que permitirá discriminación hacia la Iglesia Católica. La orden prohíbe que los empleadores y contratistas federales de discriminar contra los empleados "homosexuales" o "transexuales". Los Obispos de los EEUU dicen que esta orden está "sin precedencia y extrema" porque no incluye una excepción para las iglesias. En el futuro, si la Iglesia quiere hacer un contrato con el gobierno para fondos federales, tenemos que callarnos de nuestras enseñanzas. Empezando en 2015 la Iglesia Católica pueden ser multado por decir que el matrimonio del mismo sexo es malo. Nos prohibirán acceso a fondos federales por nuestras enseñanza morales. No nos podemos callar. No podemos parar de decir la verdad. Lo cierto es que esos comportamientos son insalubres, disgregantes, y destructivos. Los matrimonios del mismo sexo no lleva felicidad verdadero y realización. Tampoco son buenos para concebir y criar a niños. 


